## GENERAL RULES - 2023/2024

1 The league shall be managed by a Committee. The key members being:
a) Chairman (has casting vote)
b) Secretary
c) Treasurer

2 Committee members to be elected on the night of the AGM, by all who attend. A member must be nominated and then seconded.
3 At the AGM there will be one vote per team. One person can represent one team.
4a Registration fees are £30.00 per team.
$4 \mathrm{~b} \quad$ Registration form and fees to be entered on the night of the AGM. At least one team member must attend the meeting.
4c Player registrations are allowed all through the season.
4d New registrations can sign and play on the night of the match. New registrations must sign the back of the result sheet in the box provided.
4e A player registered to this Thursday league must not be registered to any other local league playing on a Thursday night. Failure to comply will result in the team losing 25-0, and the player being expelled from the league.
$4 f$ If a player leaves to play in another local league they must not return for the remainder of the current season.
5 No transfers are allowed except in exceptional circumstances and by prior approval by the committee.
6 Licensees may play for any of their teams providing they are registered with one of them. They can play for one team on the night.
$7 \quad$ Failure by a team to turn up for a match or put out a team for 2 successive weeks may lead to expulsion from the league.
8 Players registered to a team withdrawing from the league may not play for another team during the season. The team/pub and respective players may also be subject to a ban the following season.
9 It is the pubs/clubs responsibility to keep the annual trophies safe and in good condition. If lost or damaged they must be replaced or repaired by the pub/club before the next finals night.
10 Each team is required to submit a raffle prize for presentation night. The raffle prize should be brought to the presentation night or something arranged with the fixture secretary before the last round of fixtures.
11 Any complaints must be put in writing to the committee and emailed to the committee at hernebaydartsleague@gmail.com. The committee's decision is final.

## RULES OF PLAY

1a League matches to be played on Thursday nights. Certain cases may require matches to be played on other nights, subject to committee approval.
1b Cancellations are only allowed due to adverse weather conditions or exceptional circumstances. Fixture secretary must be notified at least 24 hours before the match. He will then notify the opposing team captain.
1c Spare weeks will be used first to attempt to play the games or the two captains can mutually agree when to play. The captain of the opposing team must offer the cancelling team 2 sensible dates. If they can't agree the committee will decide.

7 Teams are not allowed to change venue during the season without prior approval of the committee. Any such requests must be made in writing to the committee stating the reasons for the move.
